Note: Not all bags and bins are taken on every trip! Only in rare cases are most items taken, and even then, each bag and bin is scrutinized for what is needed given the destination. Item G is almost never taken. Bags A and B are taken only when camping is likely, as is the tent, vestibule and ground cloth. Bags C and D are the most important to take with you when exiting the aircraft in an emergency. The life vests are always worn.
